

G.H. Tool & Mold Precision Machining Scholarship

Guidelines

The purpose of the G.H. Tool & Mold Precision Machining Scholarship is to provide student(s) who have excelled in their Career and Technical Education Program of Study an award specific to the pursuit of their continued post-secondary Career and Technical Educational goals.

The award includes up to \$1,000 in tools and equipment required to be successful in the machining trade. This can be awarded to a student(s) pursuing an Associate's Degree, Bachelor's Degree, Advanced Specialized Training, or Entry Level Skilled employment. The recipient may purchase up to \$500 in tooling when the scholarship is awarded, and an additional \$500 if and when they have been an employee in good standing of G.H. Tool & Mold for at least six (6) months.

All purchases will be made through, and approved by, G.H. Tool & Mold.

To receive the award, the selected student(s) must be enrolled in schooling related to their FRCC degree/non degree program or be gainfully employed related to their completed FRCC program of study. Proof of enrollment or employment must be presented prior to being awarded the monetary scholarship value. This may include receipts, pay stubs, or other official paperwork. Proof must be submitted within one year of program completion or award will be forfeited.

Selection and Eligibility

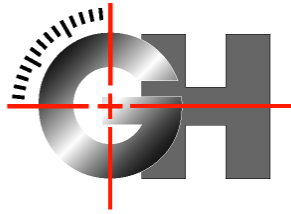
The Scholarship shall be intended for the use of the Four Rivers Career high school student graduating at the end of the 2021 school year.

For the purpose of eligibility for this scholarship, the student must have successfully met all the requirements outlined by The Four Rivers Career Center Career Preparatory Certificate:

- Completion of all sequential credits in a Career and Technical Education course specializing in Precision Machining
- Career and Technical Education GPA of 2.5 or higher
- 80% mastery of program competencies
- 95% attendance rate
- Good citizenship
- Participation in Career and Technical student organization
- Community service requirement
- Must earn bronze National Career Readiness Certificate (based on WorkKeys assessments in Applied Math, Workplace Documents, and Graphic Literacy) or composite ACT score of 18 can be substituted.

Students must complete and return the attached application by **April 23, 2021: 3:00 PM** to the FRCC main office (or on Google Classroom). Students are responsible for gathering all paperwork. Instructors will be given Instructor Input form for all qualified applications.

Awards will be presented during Four Rivers Career Center's Awards Ceremony.

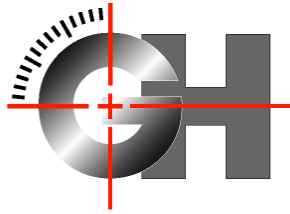
