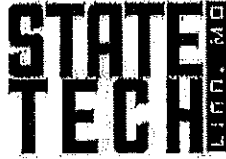

ADDITIONAL ARTICULATION REQUIREMENTS

- Students must pass the NA3SA test with a score of 80% or higher (score report should accompany the articulation agreement when sent by the school).
- High school cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale in all secondary academic coursework (not just articulation classes).
- Grades of A or B only (not average grades) in the classes used in articulation to State Tech.
- Enrollment at State Tech within 12 months of high school graduation (the first fall, spring or summer semester immediately following graduation).
