Guidelines

On behalf of the Washington Lion's Club, the John Politte Continuing Education Technical credit scholarship is designed to provide assistance to individuals pursuing a career in technical or industrial fields through community college or technical training. It is open to graduates of Washington High School or St. Francis Borgia Regional High School.

Scholarships shall be used to defray cost of tuition, books, lab fees or other expenses associated with the pursuit of a certificate or associates degree in a career or technical program.

Individuals must be enrolled in a qualified program with monetary scholarship paid to the institution. To receive these monies, individuals must show completion of previous course work with a "C" (2.0 GPA) or better.

Scholarship amount will be determined by the Scholarship Committee and will be based on need, cost of program, funds available and evaluation of the applicant by the Scholarship Committee. Evaluation of applicant shall include the application content, recommendation(s) and how the committee feels the applicant has conveyed their desire to grow and develop as a contributing member of the community. Personal interviews may be conducted as a final step before awarding scholarships.
